## Hundred Nights 3rd Annual Holiday Auction

Join us on Saturday, December 10, 2016 for a combination live and silent Holiday auction! The auction is being held in the Dining Hall at the United Church of Christ on Central Square, in Keene, NH. Parking is in the lot on the Vernon St. side of the building, and the entrance is the door with the covered ramp. Preview of available items and registration will begin at 8 am. Live bidding will begin at 9 am!

There will be a list on our website [www.hundrednightsinc.org](http://www.hundrednightsinc.org) of all available auction items, beginning on November 15th. If you see an item that you would like to bid on as part of the Silent Auction before December 8th please send an email to Mindy at [mcambiar@hundrednightsinc.org](mailto:mcambiar@hundrednightsinc.org) with your name, contact info, description of item and bid amount. The first bid that we receive that is at (or above!) face value will win the auction silently, and that item will not go up for bid at the live auction. Any item that is not won silently will be open to silent bidding during the preview, starting with the highest online bid. If the silent bidding reaches face value or above the item will not go live. Any items not won during the silent auction will go to the live auction, starting at 9 am, and bidding will begin where the silent auction left off.

Auctioneer John Pappas from Knotty Pine Auction Services in Swanzey will preside over the live portion of the event. Refreshments will be available during the event! Volunteers will be needed to set up the night before, and that day to help sell food, run auction items up to the auctioneer and then to the winning bidder, tally bid sheets and clean up after the event. ## VOLUNTEER ORIENTATIONS TO BEGIN FOR UPCOMING SHELTER SEASON

The days are getting shorter and nights are getting longer as we experience the fall and head into winter. We are reminded of how fortunate we are to have a place to live, unlike our homeless neighbors who are trying to sleep outside at this time of year. It is hard to see people in the mornings before they get the chill out of their bones when the Resource Center brews its first pot of coffee.

In preparation for opening the Cold Weather Shelter on Thanksgiving night, the staff has set up some orientation sessions for anyone interested in volunteering this coming winter season. We need many people to help with the intake process from 6:30 to either 9:30 or 10:30 pm and from 11 pm to 7 am daily. Intake volunteers greet people coming in to the shelter, help guests fill in an Intake form, bring out snacks and beverages and distribute personal care items and clothing. The overnight shift starts at 11 pm and volunteers are needed to stay awake through the night, monitoring the shelter, until 7 am. We are also hoping to fill some volunteer spots available on Saturday and Sunday afternoons.

The training sessions are scheduled at the following dates and times: Saturday, November 5th at 3pm, Tuesday, November 8th at 6pm or Saturday November 12th at 3pm. The sessions will be about two hours long. They will be held upstairs in the conference room at Hundred Nights Inc., 15 Lamson St, in Keene. If you are interested in helping out over the winter season as a Shelter Volunteer we would love to hear from you and see you at one of the training sessions!
